Ahmedabad's SVPIA Ramps Up Safety Measures

Additional facilities and arrangements in place for passenger convenience and travel advisory in view of the latest Govt. guidelines.

Ahmedabad, 23 December 2022: Sardar Vallabhabhai Patel International Airport has put in place all necessary measures to implement the Ministry of Health's latest COVID-19 guidelines on international passengers arriving in India. The new guidelines take effect from 24 December 2022.

In adherence with the latest guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoFW) for air travel, currently, 2% of all international passengers arriving at SVPI airport shall undergo random post-arrival testing at the airport. Such travellers will be identified by their respective airlines and guided to a separate dedicated area for their Covid tests.

Besides, adequate steps have been taken for RT PCR testing of passenger facilitated by SVPIA through ICMR and NABL approved laboratory. The airport has also ensured that messages on preventive measures and the latest advisories are placed strategically across the terminal. All stakeholders have been sensitized and informed to follow directives laid down by the Government from time to time.

Our teams have been extending all the necessary support to mitigate the new variant of COVID-19. Passengers are requested to cooperate with the staff. We appreciate your patience and understanding on this front for your safety and adherence to government guidelines.
