

## City airport goes through major revamp next fortnight

**Ahmedabad, 28 September 2022,** As numerous new features begin and services are added at Saradar Vallabhbhai Patel International airport in recent past, many more to come as several ongoing work comes towards the end. Recently Saradar Vallabhbhai Patel International airport crossed 28,000 passenger movement in one day and increasing. The new baggage system will help in managing the growing passenger flow especially during the upcoming festive period. There will be two carousals in the baggage make-up area that will enhance the speed, and safety of the checked in bags. The new system will also have provision for baggage drop off counters.

Apart from check-in baggage belt, new parking outside departure is nearing completion with dedicated lanes for different vehicles. International terminal too going to offer several similar infrastructural developments including extended drop off lanes, new belts in arrival hall and all overall look and feel of the terminal.
