Fire safety week observance at SVPI airport

Ahmedabad, April 20, 2023: Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport started one-week observance of fire service week with multiple activities to bring awareness to passengers and stakeholders. As a committed airport operator, the week is not the only time when safety training is conducted for teams. Multiple activities are carried out at the airport during this week.

Over the last year, more than 330 airport community members from security, medical, customer service, construction, and many other departments participated in the intensive training program. Over the last two days, more than 150 team members were given basic fire safety training to handle fire emergencies. Three hours of training conducted at the fire station once every week included training on the basics of fire safety, first aid, and operation of different fire equipment in times of emergency. At SVPIA, the teams encourage employees to share good practices, have them promoted and emulated wherever possible, while partnerships are forged to accelerate progress towards building an enhanced culture of prevention. Therefore by acting together, we become better equipped to face future crises and the many changes ahead in the future of work.

As a part of going week, a two days training program was conducted on Monday and Tuesday for different team members. Furthermore, a fire equipment demonstration and other activities will be carried out to bring awareness.
